
PURPOSE: This resolution, if approved, will amend the Navajo Nation Veterans Administration Plan of Operation.

17 **Section One. Authority**

- 18 A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the
19 Navajo Nation Council empowered to exercise oversight authority on laws and policies
20 affecting veteran services 2 N.N.C. § 400 (C) (3); 401 (C)(6).
21 B. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is also empowered to approve the
22 plan of operation for the Navajo Nation Veterans Administration pursuant to 2 N.N.C §
23 1034.

24 **Section Two. Findings**

- 25 A. The Navajo Nation Veterans Administration (NNVA) is empowered to
26 recommend policies and legislations regarding Veterans to the Navajo Nation
27 Council through the Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the
28 Navajo Nation Council consistent with applicable governmental laws and
29 policies. See **Exhibit "A"**, Section III (E).

1 B. The NNVA recommends that its current plan of operation, adopted by
2 HEISCAU-12-16, be amended as set forth in **Exhibit A**.

3 C. The proposed plan of operation set forth in Exhibit A was reviewed by NNDOJ
4 and deemed legally sufficient. See **Exhibit "B"**.

6 **Section Three. Approval**

7 A. The Health, Education and Human Services Committee of the Navajo Nation
8 Council hereby approves the amendments to the Plan of Operations for the
9 Navajo Nation Veterans Administration as set forth in **Exhibit A**.
