TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACTION RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000 THREE MILLION DOLLARS FOR EMERGENCY FUNDS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CHAPTER EMERGENCY FUNDS

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to approve a supplemental appropriative of \$3,000,000 to for emergency funds for the Department of Emergency Management.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

AUTHORITY 20 21 A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing of body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. 22 § 102(A). 23 B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §164 (A)(16) "[m]atters constituting an emergency shall be limited to the cessation of law enforcement services, and disaster relief services, fire protection 24 25 services or other direct services required as an entitlement under Navajo Nation or Federal law, or which directly threaten the sovereignty of the Navajo Nation. Such an 26 emergency matter must arise due to the pressing public need for such resolution(s) and 27 must be a matter requiring final action by the Council." 28 29 C. The Navajo Nation Council has the authority to approve supplemental appropriations. 12

N.N.C. § 820(L). Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may

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adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."

- D. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
 - All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget for budget impact analysis. 12 N.N.C. § 820(M).
 - When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond
 the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be
 approved by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
 - Supplemental Appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820(F). The Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for designation recurring and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L).
 - The Nation shall budget all recurring operating expenses, including capital maintenance, from recurring revenues. Long term debt shall not be used to finance recurring operating expenses. 12 N.N.C. §820(E).
 - 5. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[t]he Nation shall restrict non-recurring revenues to budget non-recurring expenditures. In addition, non-recurring revenues will be budgeted only after an examination by the Controller to determine whether or not the revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between recurring revenues and expenditures, and expenditures may be authorized only if a long-term (three-five year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue. Otherwise, non-recurring revenues will be added to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund balance. This provision may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the full Navajo Nation Council." 12 N.N.C. § 820(F).

SECTION 2. FINDINGS

- A. In light of the Navajo Nation's Emergency Declaration regarding the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus this supplemental funding request is made for the purpose of emergency financial stability to address all aspects of providing emergency services including, preparedness, mitigation, response, and recovery. The aim of the funding is to reduce the harmful health effects of the pandemic virus.
- B. The total amount requested is Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000). The supplemental funding proposal and budget documents are attached as **Exhibit A**.
- C. The intent of this supplemental funding request is to provide the Department of Emergency Management sufficient resources to address the health crises on the Navajo Nation and to bring chapters with less than \$15,000 in emergency funds to \$15,000. Any chapter with a zero after it in Exhibit A had at least \$15,000 in its emergency funds at the time the budget was prepared. Any chapter listed to receive more than \$15,000 had a negative balance when the documents in Exhibit A were prepared.
- D. The Executive Branch has completed a Section 164 Review which is attached as **Exhibit B**.
- E. The memorandum provided by the Office of Management and Budget, dated March 12, 2020, satisfies the budget impact analysis required by 12 N.N.C. 820(M) and is included in Exhibit B.
- F. The Office of the Controller memorandum, dated, March 12, 2020 indicating this request for funding is non-recurring. This memorandum satisfies the requirements provided in 12 N.N.C. § 820(L) and is included in **Exhibit B**.

SECTION 3. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000) FOR EMERGENCY FUNDS

A. This supplemental appropriation of \$3,000,000 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller and as indicated the documents in **Exhibit A**.

1	B. The Navajo Nation hereby approves supplemental funding from the Unreserved,
2	Undesignated Fund Balance in the amount of \$3,000,000 for emergency funds as
3	indicated in the documents in Exhibit A.
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
