**PURPOSE:** This resolution will confirm an appointment of a member of the Law and Order Committee of the Navajo Nation Council to serve as a Shareholder Representative to the Diné Development Corporation.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

## Section Three. Effective date of appointments; duration

The appointment made herein shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution by the Committee. The terms of the appointments shall be consistent with Navajo Nation law and governing documents of the corporation to which the appointment is made.
