18	A. Article V (D) of the Charter of the Navajo Oil and Gas Company states - "All rights of

21	Navajo Nation Council or their successor committees, in accordance with this Charter
22	and the applicable tribal law."
23	B. The Law and Order Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation

26	Section Two. Appointing Shareholder Representative
27	The Law and Order Committee appoints, a member of the committee, as
28	Shareholder Representative to the Navajo Oil and Gas Company.

Section Three. Effective date of appointment; duration

The appointment herein shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution by the Committee. The term of the appointment shall be consistent with Navajo Nation law and governing documents of the Navajo Oil and Gas Company.
