18 **SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY**

19 The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is a standing committee of  
20 the Navajo Nation Council empowered to coordinate all state programs with other  
21 standing committees and branches of the Navajo Nation government. 2 N.N.C. § 700 (A)  
22 and 701 (A)(4).

24 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

25 A. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council established the State Task  
26 Force as a sub-committee through the approval of Resolution NABIMY-32-15. See  
27 Exhibit A.

28 B. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee subsequently approved Resolution NABIMY-42-17  
29 amending Resolution NABIMY-32-15 to provide for six members; two from each state  
30

1 (Arizona, New Mexico and Utah) and establish regular quarterly meetings. See Exhibit  
2 B.

3 C. The Naabik'iyáti' Committee State Task Force Sub-committee is charged with  
4 conducting regular interaction with Navajo Nation lobbyists, state legislatures, officials,  
5 employees and agencies to enhance the understanding between the Navajo Nation  
6 Council and the respective states of Arizona, New Mexico and Utah. See Exhibit B.

7 D. The Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council appoints the delegates to serve on the  
8 State Task Force. See Exhibit A.

10 **SECTION THREE. APPOINTMENT**

11 The Speaker of the 24<sup>th</sup> Navajo Nation Council hereby appoints the following Delegates  
12 to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee State Task Force Sub-committee:
