PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to appoint a member from the Health Education and Human Services Committee to serve as its shareholder representative to the Navajo Times Publishing Company, Inc.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authority

The Health, Education and Human Services Committee is established as a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §400(A).

Section Two. Findings

- A. Standing committees are required to select a member to serve as a shareholder representative of the Navajo Times Publishing Company, Inc.
- B. The By-Laws of Navajo Times Publishing Company, Inc. state, “[a]s a sole shareholder, the Navajo Nation’s shares in the Corporation shall be exercised by five (5) ‘shareholder representatives’ comprised of one member from each of the five (5) standing committees of the Navajo Nation Council or their successor committees”

1 C. Through Resolution HEHSCMA-03-19 the Health, Education and Human Services
2 Committee appointed Delegate Paul Begay, Jr. to serve as shareholder representative
3 to the Navajo Times Publishing Company, Inc.

4 D. On July 24, 2019, Delegate Paul Begay, Jr., by memorandum requested to be released
5 from his assignment as shareholder representative to the Navajo Times Publishing
6 Company, Inc. The July 24, 2019 memorandum is attached as **Exhibit A**.

7 E. On March 3, 2020 Navajo Times CEO/Publisher Tom Arviso, Jr. wrote the Chairman
8 of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee requesting that another
9 member of the Health, Education and Human Services Committee be appointed as
10 Shareholder Representative. The March 3, 2020 memorandum is attached as **Exhibit**
11 **B**.
