16	A. The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council. 2	
17	N.N.C. § 700. The committee is empowered to coordinate all federal and state	
18	programs with other standing committees for purposes of providing the most efficient	
19	delivery of services to the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 701(A)(4).	
20	B. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo	
21	Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 500(A). Purposes of the committee include overseeing	
22	the efficient use of all resources of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 500(C).	
23	C. On January 8, 2019, House Bill 292 was introduced in the United States Congress.	
24	See attached Exhibit A. It is entitled "[t]he Rural Broadband Permitting Efficiency Act	
25	of 2019." The purpose of the bill is "to allow certain state and Tribal permitting	
26	authority to encourage expansion of broadband service to rural and Tribal	
27	communities." Id.	
28	D. It is in the best interests of the Navajo Nation to develop and expand high quality	
29	telecommunications, including broadband infrastructure, throughout the Navajo	
30	Nation. The immediate expansion and improvement of telecommunications is critical	

and absolutely necessary in coping with COVID-19. This contagious virus is severely impacting the health and lives of the residents and members of the Navajo Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Navajo Nation hereby supports H.R. 292, a Congressional bill Entitled "The Rural Broadband Permitting Efficiency Act Of 2019."
