PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to approve an override of the Navajo Nation's President's veto of CAP-17-20, AN ACTION RELATING TO AN EMERGENCY; ENACTING 17 N.N.C. § 338 EXCESSIVE PRICING DURING A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

18	A. All resolutions enacting new law or amending existing laws are subject to veto by the	
19	President of the Navajo Nation pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 1005(C)(10) and (11) and	
20	override by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164(A)(17).	
21	B. A vetoed resolution shall first be submitted to Naabik'iyati' Committee before	
22	consideration by the Council. 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(17).	
23	C. Veto legislation passed by the Navajo Nation Council [is] subject to an override of the	
24	veto by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of the Navajo Nation Council. 2

27	Section Two. Findings	
28	A. The Navajo Nation approved the enactment of a new offense to Title 17, Law and	
29	Order, entitled the "Excessive pricing during a declared state of emergency." The	
30	Council Resolution CAP-17-20 approving the new offense is attached as Exhibit A.	

1	B. The Navajo Nation President vetoed CAP-17-20 on April 23, 2020 and provided a
2	memorandum, attached as Exhibit B, to support his decision to veto Council
3	Resolution CAP-17-20.
