<u>NOTE</u>: Expenditure from the principal and income of the Síhasin Fund requires a 2/3 vote of all members of the Navajo Nation Council in accordance with 12 N. N. C. § 2505 (A).

PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to approve an expenditure from the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund in the amount of \$3,098,800 to the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority for a 62 Chapter House Broadband Project.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate review the proposed resolution in detail.

D. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. § 301 (B) (2).

Section Two. The Naabik'íyáti Síhasin Fund Subcommittee and Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund

A. The Naabik'íyáti Committee of the 24th Navajo Nation Council continued the Naabik'íyáti Síhasin Fund Subcommittee in Resolution NABIAP-23-19. The Naabik'íyáti Síhasin Fund Subcommittee was initially established in 2015 by Resolution NABIAP-20-15 to provide recommendations to the Naabik'íyáti Committee and Navajo Nation Council for projects to be funded using Síhasin Funds. Notwithstanding the creation and continuation of the Naabik'íyáti Síhasin Fund Subcommittee, approval from the Subcommittee is not a requirement for the Navajo Nation Council to approve Síhasin Fund expenditure plans.

B. The Navajo Nation Code provides the purpose of the Navajo Nation Síhasin Fund ("Síhasin Fund") is as follows:

§2502 Purpose

 A. The purposes of this Fund are to provide financial support and/or financing for:

201. The planning and development of economic development21and regional infrastructure supporting economic development22and community development, including such infrastructure23as, but not limited to, housing, commercial and government24buildings, waterline, solid waste management development,25powerline projects, and transportation and communication26systems, within the Navajo Nation; and272. Education opportunities for members of the Navajo28Nation.

4	Section Five. Approval and Adoption of Expenditure Plan Administration
5	A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves administration of the 62 Chapter House
6	Broadband Project Expenditure Plan as follows:
7	1. The Navajo Nation Controller shall determine whether the source of the three
8	million ninety-eight thousand eight hundred dollars (\$3,098,800) will be Síhasin
9	Fund Principal or Income or a combination of both;
10	2. The funds allocated to NTUA shall be used to design, plan, and construct the 62
11	Chapter House Broadband Project, as set forth in Exhibit A, and NTUA shall
12	return any and all cost-savings to the Síhasin Fund once the 62 Chapter House
13	Broadband Project is fully completed or with the approval of the Naabik'íyáti'
14	Committee, use such cost-savings for broadband access to additional chapter
15	houses.
16	3. The Navajo Nation Controller shall release the funds to NTUA during Navajo
17	Nation Fiscal Year 2019 pursuant to a project budget plan or other such
18	schedule agreed to by the Office of the Controller and NTUA within thirty (30)
19	days of the formal adoption of this legislation;
20	4. The funds allocated for the 62 Chapter House Broadband Project shall not lapse
21	on an annual basis pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820 (N) or otherwise be returned to
22	or deposited in the Síhasin Fund Principal or Navajo Nation General Fund until
23	the earlier of five (5) years from the date of adoption of this legislation or such
24	time as the 62 Chapter House Broadband Project, as set forth in Exhibit A, is
25	fully completed.
26	B. The NTUA General Manager and Management Board shall have an ongoing
27	responsibility to make all efforts to secure additional funding from external sources
28	to reduce the use of Síhasin Funds to complete the 62 Chapter House Broadband
29	Project.

C. The NTUA General Manager and Management Board shall account for and be held 1 accountable for the expenditure of Síhasin Fund funds and shall account for such 2 funds pursuant to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles and an account or 3 fund management plan approved by the NTUA President and reported to the Board 4 of Directors which shall at least include provisions that: 5 1. The accounting and financial records for the Síhasin Fund funds shall be kept 6 separate from other NTUA funds and accounts; and 7 2. The use of the Síhasin Fund funds shall be audited on an annual basis by an 8 independent auditor with such audit report submitted to the Naabik'iyati' 9 Committee, Office of the Controller, and Office of the President and Vice-10 President. 11 D. The NTUA General Manager shall report the status of the project, as well as NTUA 12 efforts to secure funding from external sources, to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee and 13 14 Office of the President and Vice-President on a semi-annual basis. 15 Section Six. Effective Date 16 The 62 Chapter House Broadband Project Expenditure Plan, as set forth above, shall 17 18 become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 2505. 19 Section Seven. Directives 20 A. All Navajo Nation programs, specifically including, but not limited to, the Office of 21 Controller and Office of Management & Budget, and NTUA staff and Management 22 Board, shall take all steps necessary to expeditiously implement the 62 Chapter 23 House Broadband Project Expenditure Plan consistent with the provisions set forth 24 25 above. B. The NTUA General Manager and Management Board, as well as Navajo Nation 26 programs named in this legislation, shall report on a semi-annual basis to the 27 Naabik'iyáti' Committee and Office of the President and Vice-President on the 28 progress of their respective tasks. 29 30

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
