- B. Budget documents indicate the original budget approved by the Navajo Nation Council for Fiscal Year 2019 was \$200,000. A budget modification of \$51,910 will result in a total budget amount of \$251,910 for Fiscal year 2019.
- C. The Fund Management Plan for the Veterinary Management Program, attached as Exhibit B, allows for the expenditure of funds for personnel and benefits, travel expenses, veterinary supply expenses, communication and utilities, repair & maintenance, contractual services, special transactions, and capital outlay. SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF BUDGET MODIFICATION FOR THE VETERINARY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

The Resources and Development Committee hereby approves the budget modification increase in the amount of \$51,910, increasing the total budget for the Veterinary Management Program to \$251,910 as indicated in the budget forms in **Exhibit A**.
