27 all proposed legislation which requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2

29 C. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §
30 102 (A).

1 **Section Two. Findings**

- 2 A. The Navajo Nation approved Council Resolution CAP-35-18, attached as **Exhibit B**,
3 titled, "Adopting the Sihasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan
