

Farm Boards' stipend and per diem payments fluctuates annually depending on the Navajo Nation Council decisions and the availability funds. Compared to the Eastern Navajo Land Board and Grazing Officials, the Farm Boards' stipends and per diem budget is not set as a statu thereby an annual budget projection is a challenge for the Department of Agriculture. Stipend and per diem payments is based on the annu program budget allocation, thus sets the compensation at the lowest rates. The Budget and Finance Committee recommends concerted effort resolve the inequitable stipends and per diem payments by setting standard rates.
