 - Legislation proposes to change the designation name from "Navajo Nation" to "Diné Nation."
 - On January 26, 2017 (Winter Session), the Navajo Nation Council TABLED Legislation 0395-16 to the 2017 Spring Session by a vote of 14 in favor 3 opposed through a motion by Hon. Kee Allen Begay, Jr. and second by Hon. Norman M. Begay
 - With instructions: A work session is called, considering that, if adopted, the change will be effective in the Fall 2017
 - Request Elders and Navajo Nation Code Talkers perspectives
 - Provide cost estimates on implementing the name change
 - Seek chapter resolutions for the people's input
 - Research the origin of the "Diné"
