16	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
17	A. Pursuant to 6 N.N.C. §606 (A), [t]he Board Members shall be appointed, and may be	
18	reappointed, by the Nominations Committee composed of the Navajo Nation	
19	President, Speaker of the Navajo Nation Council, Resources and Development	
20	Committee designee, and confirmed by the Naabik'iyati' Committee of the Navajo	
21	Nation Council.	
22	B. Pursuant to 6 N.N.C. §606 (A), a resolution of the Naabik'iyati' Committee of the	
23	Navajo Nation Council as to the appointment or reappointment of any Commissioner	
24	shall be conclusive evidence of the due and proper appointment of the Commissioner.	
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26	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
27	A. Pursuant to 6 N.N.C. § 602 (A), The Navajo Nation established a public body of the	
28	Navajo Nation known as the Navajo Housing Authority (Authority) to: remedy	
29	unsafe and unsanitary housing conditions that are injurious to the public health, safety	

and morals; alleviate the acute shortage of decent, safe, and sanitary dwellings for

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- persons of low income; provide employment opportunities through the construction, reconstruction, improvement, extension, alteration or repair operation of low income dwellings; and promote economic growth and development activities within and near the Navajo Nation. *See* 6 N.N.C. § 604 (A)-(D).
- B. The affairs of the Authority shall be managed by a Board of Commissioners composed of five persons. 6 N.N.C. § 605; CJA-13-17.
- C. Pursuant to 6 N.N.C. § 606, the Nominations Committee has appointed Mr. David N. Sloan. The appointment letter is attached as **Exhibit A**.
- D. All Commissioners at a minimum, shall have post-high school education and employment experience in at least one of the areas of business operations, architecture, construction management, finance, accounting, investing, or in other specialized areas of construction or business that correspond to the activities or anticipated activities of the Authority, and at least three years of management or leadership experience in business or a local unit of government. 6 N.N.C. § 606 (B); CJA-13-17.
- E. Mr. Sloan's letter of interest and resume are attached as **Exhibit B**. Mr. Sloan's resume states that he has a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Architecture from the University of New Mexico.
- F. One Commissioner of the five, shall be a Registered Architect or licensed Professional Engineer. 6 N.N.C. § 606 (B); CJA-13-17. Mr. Sloan's Architect licenses from the State of New Mexico and State of Arizona are attached as **Exhibit** C.
- G. A majority of the Commissioners shall be members of the Navajo Nation. 6 N.N.C. § 606 (B); CJA-13-17. Mr. David N. Sloan's Navajo Nation Certificate of Indian Blood is attached as **Exhibit D**.
- H. The term of office shall be four years and staggered. When a Board is first established, one member's term shall be designated to expire in one year, another to expire in two years, a third to expire in three years, and the last two in four years. Thereafter, all appointments shall be for four years. 6 N.N.C. § 607.

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I. The term of years for the appointment of Mr. Sloan shall be in accordance with 6 N.N.C. § 607.

## SECTION THREE. CONFIRMING APPOINTMENT

Pursuant to 6 N.N.C. 606 (B) and 6 N.N.C. § 607, the Naabik'iyati' Committee hereby confirms the appointment of Mr. David N. Sloan to serve on the Navajo Housing Authority Board of Commissioners.
