

TITLE OF RESOLUTION: AN ACT RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, BUDGET AND FINANCE, AND NAA'BIK'ÍYÁTI' COMMITTEES, AND THE NAVAJO NATION COUNCIL; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,244,913.00 FOR THE NAVAJO DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS TO CONTINUE PROVIDING EFFECTIVE SERVICES FOR THE NAVAJO NATION; WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820 (E), (F), AND (J)

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is for the Navajo Nation to approve \$1,244,913.00 in supplemental funding out of the UUFB for the Navajo Department of Criminal Investigations.

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20	BE IT ENACTED:
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22	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY
23	A. The Navajo Nation established the Law and Order Committee ("LOC") as a Navajo
24	Nation Council standing committee, and as such gave LOC oversight over all
25	departments within the Navajo Division of Public Safety. 2 N.N.C. §§ 600(A),
26	600(C)(5).
27	B. The Navajo Nation established the Budget and Finance Committee ("BFC") as a
28	Navajo Nation Council standing committee, and as such empowered BFC to review
29	and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the management of all funds. 2 N.N.C.
30	§§ 300(A), and 301(B)(2).

C. The Navajo Nation Council established the Naabik'íyáti' Committee as a Navajo 1 Nation standing committee, and proposed legislation requiring final action by the 2 Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §§ 3 164(A)(9) and 700(A). 4 D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation, with the 5 authority to approve supplemental appropriations. 2 N.N.C. § 102(A), 12 N.N.C. § 6 820(L). 7 E. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve 8 supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal 9 year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are 10 permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or 11 current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve 12 amount set forth at § 820(J)." 13 F. The Title 12 Supplemental Appropriation requirements include: 14 1. All requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted 15 to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for budget impact analysis. 12 16 N.N.C. § 820(M). 17 2. When the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond 18 the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be 19 approved by the Navajo Nation Council. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L). 20 3. Supplemental Appropriations made from non-recurring revenues shall only be 21 made for non-recurring operations or purposes, as set forth at § 820(F). The 22 Controller of the Navajo Nation shall be responsible for the designation of recurring 23 and non-recurring revenues. 12 N.N.C. § 820(L). 24 4. The Nation shall budget all recurring operating expenses, including capital 25 maintenance, from recurring revenues. Long term debt shall not be used to finance 26 recurring operating expenses. 12 N.N.C. §820(E). 27 5. The Navajo Nation Code provides, "[t]he Nation shall restrict non-recurring 28 29 revenues to budget non-recurring expenditures. In addition, non-recurring revenues will be budgeted only after an examination by the Controller to determine whether 30

or not the revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between recurring revenues and expenditures, and expenditures may be authorized only if a long-term (three-five year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue. Otherwise, non-recurring revenues will be added to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund balance. This provision may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the full Navajo Nation Council." 12 N.N.C. § 820(F).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. This request for supplemental funding seeks the amount of \$1,244,913.00 out of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance, to assist the Navajo Department of Criminal Investigations ("NDCI") in continuing to provide its daily services in an efficient and effective manner, while complying with required COVID-19 protocols. NDCI reports that its FY2021 base funding allocation is not enough sufficient to meet NDCI's operational demands at all districts, due to increased financial burdens resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, with NDCI having to ensure proper safety protocols for its staff and community members according to CDC and Navajo Nation guidelines.

 B. The supplemental funding proposal, budget forms and related documents, including Appendix K "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary," for NDCI are attached as Exhibit A.

C. The Office of the Controller issued a memorandum dated March 17, 2021, to satisfy the requirements in 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), attached as Exhibit B. The Controller has identified the NDCI expenditures as RECURRING and therefore a waiver of 12 N.N.C. § 820(E), (F), and (J) is required.

D. The Office of Management and Budget issued a memorandum dated March 24, 2021, to satisfy the requirements in 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), attached as Exhibit C.

SECTION THREE. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE

A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves \$1,244,913.00 in supplemental funding from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance for the Navajo Department of Criminal

Investigations.

B. This supplemental appropriation of \$1,244,913.00 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance as determined by the Office of the Controller.

SECTION FOUR. WAIVING 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(E), (F), AND (J)

The Navajo Nation Council hereby waives 12 N.N.C. §§ 820(E), (F) and (J) in order to allow funds out of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance to be used for recurring expenditures and government operations.

SECTION 5. SAVING CLAUSE

Should any provision(s) of this Act be determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court or the District Courts of the Navajo Nation, without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of the Act shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this Act shall become effective in accordance with 2 N.N.C. § 221.
