15	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
16	(A) Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §3352(B), the President of the Navajo Nation has the authority to	
17	appoint members of the Navajo Tax Commission.	
18	(B) The Naabik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council	
19	and is empowered to give final confirmation of the Navajo Nation President's	
20	appointments to boards, commissions, and colleges, unless otherwise provided by law.	
21	2 N.N.C. §700(A) and §701(A)(1).

23	SECTION TWO. FINDINGS	
24	(A) The Navajo Tax Commission is established under the Executive Branch of the Navajo	
25	Nation Government. 2 N.N.C. §3351.	
26	(B) The Navajo Tax Commission consists of five (5) members, at least three (3) of whom	
27	shall be enrolled Navajo Nation members. 2 N.N.C. §3352(A).	
28	(C) Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §3352(B), the President of the Navajo Nation shall, at the times	
29	required under Subsection (C) and (E), nominate a person qualified by virtue of	
30	education, experience, or office, and upon confirmation by the Government Services	

Committee of the Navajo Nation Council, such person shall be appointed to serve a term as a commissioner of the Navajo Tax Commission. Pursuant to Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CO-45-12, the "Government Services Committee" now means the Naabik'íyáti' Committee.

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- (D) Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §3352(C), the terms of office of commissioners shall be five (5) years; provided however, that in order to stagger the expiration of terms of office, March 31 of each year shall be the common anniversary date.
- (E) Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §3352(D), a commissioner shall be removed only for cause by the President of the Navajo Nation and upon ratification by the Naabik'íyáti' Committee of the Navajo Nation Council; provided that the person so removed may then appeal his/her removal to the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation. For the purposes of this Subsection, "cause" means:
  - 1. Incapacity. Physical or mental incapacity where such incapacity extends or is expected to extend longer than six months.
  - Nonfcasance. Failure to perform the duties of office, including, but not limited to, repeated and unexcused failure to attend the meetings and other official functions of the Commission.
  - 3. Ex parte violation. Participation in ex parte consultation with any representative of a taxpayer who is an appellant in a dispute before or with the Commission.
  - Certain other acts. Any act that is a felony in the jurisdiction where committed, or any act involving moral turpitude that is a misdemeanor in the jurisdiction where committed.
  - 5. A vacancy in the Commission, whether caused by death, removal, or resignation shall be filled by an interim appointment to complete the vacated term made in accordance with this Section.
- (F) By letter dated May 28, 2021, the President of the Navajo Nation appointed Shana Barehand to serve on the Navajo Tax Commission. Letter attached as Exhibit A.
- (G) Ms. Barchand's letter of interest and resume are attached as **Exhibit B** and **Exhibit C**.

1	SECTION THREE. CONFIRMATION
2	Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. §3352(B), the Naabik'íyáti' Committee hereby confirms the
3	appointment of Shana Barehand to serve on the Navajo Tax Commission for a term of five
4	(5) years beginning as of April 1, 2020 and ending on March 31, 2025.
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
