

17 **SECTION ONE. Authority**

19 A. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 500(C)(6), the Resources and Development Committee has
20 oversight authority over matters including planning and coordination of roads and
21 transportation activities of the Navajo Nation.
22 B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501(C) the Resource and Development Committee has
23 oversight authority over the Navajo Division of Transportation.

25 **SECTION TWO. Findings**

- 26 A. The Navajo Nation Division of Transportation submits the Navajo Long Range
27 Transportation Plan to the United States Department of Transportation, Federal
28 Highway Administration.
29 B. Pursuant to 25 C.F.R. § 170.410 (a) The purpose of long-range transportation
30 planning is to clearly demonstrate a tribe's transportation needs and to fulfill tribal

1 goals by developing strategies to meet these needs. These strategies should address
2 future land use, economic development, traffic demand, public safety, and health
3 and social needs.

4 C. The 2021 Navajo Nation Long Range Transportation Plan is attached hereto as
5 **Exhibit A.**
