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21	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
22	A. The Health, Education, and Human Services Committee is a standing committee of the	
23	Navajo Nation Council that oversees matters involving education and school board	
24	organizations. 2 N.N.C. §400(C)(1), 2 N.N.C. §401(C)(4).	
25	B. The Resources and Development Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation	
26	Council with authority over matters involving public utilities and community	
27	development. 2 N.N.C. §500(C).	
28	B. The Budget and Finance Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation	
29	Council, empowered to review and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the	
30	budgeting, appropriation, investment, and management of all funds. 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2).	

- C. The Naa'bik'íyáti' Committee is a standing committee of the Navajo Nation Council that is responsible for reviewing proposed resolutions requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).
- D. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §102(A). As such, the Council has the authority to approve supplemental appropriations. "The Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at §820(J)." 12 N.N.C. §820(L).
- E. The restrictions on supplemental appropriations include:
 - 1. Supplemental appropriations from non-recurring revenues shall be approved only for non-recurring expenses. 12 N.N.C. §820(F). The Controller determines which revenues are recurring and which are non-recurring. 12 N.N.C. §820(L).
 - 2. The Navajo Nation shall budget all recurring operating expenses, including capital maintenance costs, from recurring revenues only; and long-term debt shall not be used to finance recurring operating expenses. 12 N.N.C. §820(E).
 - 3. The Navajo Nation Code further provides, ". . . non-recurring revenues will be budgeted only after an examination by the Controller to determine whether or not the revenues are subsidizing an imbalance between recurring revenues and expenditures, and expenditures may be authorized only if a long-term (three-five year) forecast shows that the operating deficit will not continue. Otherwise, non-recurring revenues will be added to the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance. This provision may be amended or waived by a two-thirds vote of the full Navajo Nation Council." 12 N.N.C. §820(F).
 - 4. All requests for supplemental funding shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. 12 N.N.C. §820(M).

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

A. The Division of Community Development ("DCD") is requesting \$3,600,000 in supplemental funds out of the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance ("UUFB") to pay

- for the upgrading and replacement of a high-voltage electricity line and electrical system that serves the Pine Hill School, which is under the Ramah Navajo School Board, Inc. See Appendix K "Supplemental Funding Proposal Summary," attached hereto as **EXHIBIT A**.
- B. As explained in the Construction Report and other related Project documents attached as **EXHIBIT B**, the \$3,600,000 is needed to perform extensive refurbishment of existing power and distribution facilities, which activities will include the replacement of old and worn electric cables and voltage boxes.
- C. DCD has provided other required Budget Forms, including a "Program Budget Summary," a "Program Performance Criteria," and a "Detailed Budget and Justification," which pages are attached as **EXHIBIT C**.
- D. The Ramah Navajo School Board, Inc. passed Resolution No. RNSB-EXEC-2021-070 dated October 12, 2021, wherein it approved the request for the Navajo Nation to provide funds for this high-voltage line Project, to better serve the Pine Hill School. **EXHIBIT D**.
- E. In accordance with 12 N.N.C. §820(L), the Office of the Controller has provided a memorandum regarding this UUFB funding request, designating the high-voltage line Project for the Pine Hill School as a *non-recurring* expense. **EXHIBIT E**.
- F. In compliance with 12 N.N.C. §820(M), OMB has reviewed this UUFB funding request and provided its comments and concerns in an email dated December 2, 2021. **EXHIBIT F**.

SECTION THREE. ALLOCATING \$3,600,000 FROM THE UUFB TO THE DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby allocates \$3,600,000 from the UUFB to the Division of Community Development for DCD's use in paying for the high-voltage electricity line upgrade/replacement Project urgently needed by the Pine Hill School. DCD's expenditures of the \$3,600,000 approved herein shall conform to the listings and descriptions of all Project costs, as shown in **EXHIBITS A** and **B**.
- B. This \$3,600,000 supplemental appropriation shall be from those funds that exceed the minimum fund reserve balance in the UUFB required by 12 N.N.C. §820(J), as determined by the Controller.
- C. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §820(N) this supplemental appropriation shall expire, and any funds

not expended or encumbered by DCD for the high-voltage line Project by midnight on September 30, 2022 shall revert to the UUFB, unless the Navajo Nation Council determines otherwise. SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE This Act shall become effective as provided in 2 N.N.C. §221(B) and 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(17). SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE If any portion of this Act is determined invalid by the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, or by a District Court of the Navajo Nation without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the remainder of this Act shall be the law of the Navajo Nation.
