TITLE OF RESOLUTION: PROPOSED STANDING COMMITTEE RESOLUTION; AN ACTION RELATING TO RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING THE GRANT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY TO CONTINENTAL DIVIDE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., FOR THE GILBERT YAZZIE POWERLINE PROJECT LOCATED ON NAVAJO NATION TRUST LANDS IN CHICHILTAH CHAPTER VICINITY (MCKINLEY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO)

PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to approve the Grant of Right-of-Way to Continental Divide Electric Cooperative, Inc. for the Gilbert Yazzie Powerline Project to construct, operate and maintain a 14.4/24.9 kV electrical/fiber optic distribution line on, over and across Navajo Nation Trust Lands in Chichiltah Chapter vicinity (McKinley County, New Mexico). The legislation would waive the consideration/compensation pursuant to RDCF-08-20.

This written summary does not address recommended amendments as may be provided by the standing committees. The Office of Legislative Counsel requests each Council Delegate to review each proposed resolution in detail.

18	Section One. Authority	
19	Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. Section §501 (B)(2), The Resources and Development	
20	Committee of the Navajo Nation Council has the authority to grant final approval	
21	for all land withdrawals, non-mineral leases, permits, licenses, rights-of-way,	
22	surface easements and bonding requirements on Navajo Nation lands and	
23	unrestricted (fee) land. This authority shall include subleases, modifications,	
24	assignments, leasehold encumbrances, transfers, renewals, and terminations.

26	Section Two. Findings	
27	A. The Continental Divide Electric Cooperative, Inc., P.O. Box 1087, Grants, New	
28	Mexico 87020, has submitted a right-of-way application to construct, operate and	
29	maintain 14.4/29.9 kV electrical/fiber optic distribution line to serve the Chichiltah	
30	Chapter. The Terms and Conditions is attached hereto and incorporated herein as	

Exhibit A.

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- B. The proposed right-of-way is described in map and description attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit B.**
- C. The District 16 Grazing Official/Land Board member in a document dated September 28, 2021, identified three grazing permittees with land use rights in the affect lands. The land users consented to the use of the lands for the purposes of the right-of-way easement for construction, operation, and maintenance of 14.4/24.9 kV electric distribution power line and fiber optic line and its appurtenances to serve Chichiltah Chapter "Gilbert Yazzie Project." The District 16 Grazing Official/Land Board member's document dated September 28, 2021 and the land users consent forms are attached as Exhibit C.
- D. A waiver of compensation for this right-of-way is requested. See, 25 CFR § 169.110. Exhibit A, the terms and conditions document states that the compensation for a twenty-year right-of-way is \$54,307.08.
- E. The Resources and Development Committee, through resolution number RDCF-08-20 allows for one-hundred (100%) waiver of right-of-way consideration for non-profit electric utility companies that provide service to Navajo residents on Navajo Trust land in the Eastern Navajo Agency.
- F. The requested right-of-way is located on Navajo trust land in the Eastern Navajo Agency and Continental Divide Electric Company is a non-profit electric company.
- G. The environmental studies and archaeological clearances including Exhibit D, the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) dated July 23, 2021; Exhibit E, the Heritage and Historic Preservation Department Cultural Resources Compliance Form HPD-20-074; Exhibit F, the Biological Resources Compliance Form, NNDFW Review No. 19danl103; Exhibit G, the Gilbert Yazzie Power Line Biological Evaluation prepared by Denali Environmental Services dated February 2020; and Exhibit H, the Gilbert Yazzie Power Line Environmental Assessment prepared by Denali Environmental Services dated.
- H. The Right of Way Application is attached as Exhibit I.
- I. The application for the Right-of-Way as submitted by the Continental Divide

Electric Cooperative, Inc., has been reviewed Executive Official Review process, including review by the Department of Justice and "Approved" or found "Sufficient". Executive Official Review Document No. 017540 is attached as **Exhibit J**.

Section Three. Approval

- A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the Grant of Right-of-Way to Continental Divide Electric Cooperative, Inc. for the Gilbert Yazzie Powerline Project to construct, operate and maintain a 14.4/24.9 kV electrical/fiber optic distribution line on, over and across Navajo Nation Trust Lands in Chichiltah Chapter vicinity (McKinley County, New Mexico). The location is more particularly described on the survey map attached hereto as **Exhibit B.**
- B. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby waives compensation of one-hundred percent (100%) of the assessed \$54,307.08 for the right-of-way project for 20-year term because it has been determined that accepting the agreed-upon compensation is in its best interest of the Navajo Nation, pursuant to Title 25 CFR § 169.110.
- C. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby approves the right-of-way subject to, but not limited to, the following terms and conditions incorporated herein and attached as **Exhibit A**.
- D. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation to execute any and all documents necessary to affect the intent and purpose of this resolution.
