- 10. Actively seek funding for broadband infrastructure projects on the Navajo Nation and serve as the sole conduit of information regarding funds for broadband infrastructure projects on the Navajo Nation.
 - 11. Actively seek E-Rate funding and administer E. Rate projects on behalf of the Navajo Nation.
- 12. May serve as a co-designee on grants for the development of broadband infrastructure projects on the Navajo Nation by entities within, owned, and/or controlled by the Navajo Nation government.
