19	SECTION ONE. AUTHORITY	
20	A. The Resources and Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to	
21	exercise oversight authority over Chapter activities. 2 N.N.C. §500(C).	
22	B. The Budget and Finance Committee of the Navajo Nation Council is empowered to review	
23	and recommend to the Navajo Nation Council the budgeting, appropriation, investment and	
24	management of all funds, and to coordinate and review all fiscal, financial and investment	
25	activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. §301(B)(2) and §301(B)(5).	
26	C. The Navajo Nation Council approved Resolution No. CAP-35-18, titled: "Adopting the	
27	Síhasin Fund Powerline and Chapter Projects Expenditure Plan Pursuant to CD-68-14, as	
28	Amended by CJA-03-18, and 12 N.N.C. §§ 2501-2508, as Amended; Waiving 12 N.N.C. §§	
29	810 (F), 820 (I) And (M) And 860 (C) Relating to the Capital Improvement Budget and the	
30	Capital Improvement Process." CAP-35-18 is incorporated herein by reference.	
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D. Section 4(C) of CAP-35-18 specifically provides: "A chapter project, powerline, or waterline project may be changed, including the year funded, or added to Exhibits A through E with the concurrence of the Delegate representing the chapter's Council District and the approvals of the Resources and Development Committee and Budget and Finance Committee, as long as such project has been certified as construction-ready by CPMD or NTUA and the total Síhasin Funding for the District does not exceed \$4,166,666.67."

SECTION TWO. FINDINGS

- A. The amount of \$1,265,035.70 for the Nahata Dziil Shopping Center Project was approved in Exhibit D to CAP-35-18. The CAP-35-18 Exhibit D showing the Nahata Dziil Project No. D-147 is attached hereto as EXHIBIT 1.
- B. There are leftover funds of \$617,991.22 remaining after the completion of the Nahata Dziil
 Shopping Center Project. The Houck, Lupton, and Klagetoh Chapters desire to use these
 leftover funds for several Projects in their communities.
- C. On behalf of the Chapter, the Division of Community Development Capital Projects Management Department ("CPMD") has submitted two Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Forms describing the requested changes. EXHIBIT 2. The Síhasin Project Amendment Certification Forms show the signature of the Navajo Nation Council Delegate for the Chapters, in accordance with CAP-35-18 Section 4(C).
- D. As required by CAP-35-18 Section 4(C), the new Project allocations have been certified by CPMD as construction-ready and the total Síhasin funding for the Council District will not exceed \$4,166,666.67. In fact, the original Síhasin funding amount of \$1,265,035.70 for the Nahata Dziil Shopping Center Project, as approved in CAP-35-18, will remain unchanged.

SECTION THREE. APPROVAL OF CHANGE TO CAP-35-18

- A. The Navajo Nation hereby approves a change to Resolution No. CAP-35-18, Exhibit D,
 Project No. D-147, by approving use of \$617,991.22 in leftover funds that remain after the
 completion of the Nahata Dziil Shopping Center Project, for six other Projects located in the
 Houck, Lupton, and Klagetoh Chapters.
- 30 B. The Síhasin Fund may be reimbursed the funds reallocated herein, from other funds available

to the Navajo Nation from any and all state, federal, or other sources.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Action shall become effective pursuant to 12 N.N.C. §2505(A) and CAP-35-18, Section 4(C).

SECTION FIVE. SAVING CLAUSE

If any provision of this Action is determined invalid by the Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation, or by a Navajo Nation District Court without appeal to the Navajo Nation Supreme Court, the provision(s) not determined invalid shall remain the law of the Navajo Nation.
