17	Section One. Authorities
18	A. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight authority over roads and
19	transportation to oversee planning and coordination of all roads and transportation
20	activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C)(6).
21	B. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight authority over the Navajo
22	Division of Transportation. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C) (1).

24	Section Two. Findings
25	A. Pursuant to 25 C.F.R. Part 170, Subpart D of the Tribal Transportation Program, the
26	Navajo Division of Transportation is charged with performing the critical functions in
27	collaboration with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, local, state and federal agencies to
28	develop a tribal transportation priority listing.
29	B. The Navajo Division of Transportation prepared the FY2023 Navajo Nation Tribal
30	Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP), Exhibit A. Projects listed on the 5-year

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TTIP have funds programmed for: preliminary studies including cultural, environmental impact studies, rights-of-way, centerline surveys and design; construction engineering funds for construction administration; and, construction funds to construct roadway improvements.

C. The Resources and Development Committee approved Tribal Transportation Improvement Program is to be submitted to the Federal Highway Administration.

D. Approving the FY2023 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program is in the Navajo Nation's best interest.

The Navajo Nation hereby approves the FY2023 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program as found at **Exhibit A**.
