BE IT ENACTED:

Section One. Authorities

- A. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight authority over roads and transportation to oversee planning and coordination of all roads and transportation activities of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C. § 500 (C)(6).
- B. The Resources and Development Committee has oversight authority over the Navajo Division of Transportation. 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C) (1).

Section Two. Findings

- A. Pursuant to 25 C.F.R. Part 170, Subpart D of the Tribal Transportation Program, the Navajo Division of Transportation is charged with performing the critical functions in collaboration with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, local, state and federal agencies to develop a tribal transportation priority listing.
- B. The Navajo Division of Transportation prepared the FY2023 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP), **Exhibit A**. Projects listed on the 5-year

1 TTIP have funds programmed for: preliminary studies including cultural,
2 environmental impact studies, rights-of-way, centerline surveys and design;
3 construction engineering funds for construction administration; and, construction funds
4 to construct roadway improvements.

5 C. The Resources and Development Committee approved Tribal Transportation
6 Improvement Program is to be submitted to the Federal Highway Administration.

7 D. Approving the FY2023 Navajo Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Program is
8 in the Navajo Nation's best interest.
